The archive of the Society has many photographs taken well over a range of 100 years. The images of this area taken by William Jackson in 1911-1914 are well known. He was General Manager of the North British Railway but also a keen amateur photographer. 1911 was the year of the coronation of King George V so it is interesting to compare Jackson's photograph of Rosebery Terrace with the same view on the day of King Charles III's crowning.



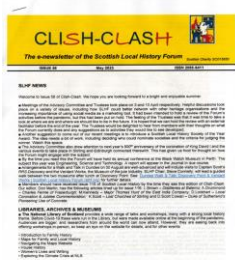
The lack of bunting is striking.
